Forum: SUCCESS AND FAILURE: EARLY INTERVENTIONS WITH INFANTS AND THEIR FAMILIES.

Which are the main factors that facilitate or block the use of the scientific knowledge we have about the baby in the field of public political measures and in the implementation of programs directed to the babies and their families? Which are the conditions that frequently threaten the continuity of the actions that are beneficial to the infants? On the other hand, how can we determine why some actions provide a continuity of working on a favourable basis? Which are the social, cultural, economical and psychological conditions that allow the development of programs and researches that are advantageous to the infants, their families and the professionals involved?

Forum's working procedures - The proposal for this Forum is inspired on the workshops coordinated by the Brazilian Association for the Study of the Baby- ABEBÊ during the V^o World Social Forum in Porto Alegre, Brazil, January 2005. The World Social Forum has as its main theme "another world is possible". During the World Social Forum we kept asking ourselves what were the necessary conditions to make another world become possible for the babies in situations of risk. This question remains so important that we are bringing it up again into discussion with colleagues from different countries in Paris. We are inviting them to share their experiences working with babies and their families, whether they are successful or not, in diverse social-economical environments.

We will start making brief interventions in order to stimulate the participants to relate their experiences and to facilitate an atmosphere open for debate and free discussion where all the members can interact and relate their point of view. Our main objective is to achieve a possible elaboration of the subjects brought up by the group during the discussions. This Forum intends to be an open space to welcome different perspectives, offering the opportunity to share with colleagues from various parts of the world our experiences, our difficulties and the creative ways we find to deal with all the issues related to working in the field of early infancy.
